Submitting your resignation

a) If you are a **private practitioner**, please provide a **letter of resignation** to administrator@lawsociety.nu.ca; the letter should detail the disposition of any:

- i. open and closed files,
- ii. wills, titles and other important valuable documents,
- iii. non-documentary valuables,
- iv. trust monies, trust accounts and books of account, that relate to your practice in Nunavut that are within your control.

b) If you are **not a private practitioner** (In-house counsel, government lawyer, etc.), please provide a **letter of resignation** to administrator@lawsociety.nu.ca ; the letter should stipulate that you have no files that relate to practice in Nunavut.

Please note that pursuant to Ss. 15 (1) and (2) of the *Legal Profession Act* no member may resign from the Society unless his or her resignation is submitted to and accepted by the Executive; and upon acceptance, the name of the member shall be struck from the Roll.
