- 1. **Recorded PD events** will be available for the Membership (Subject to consent from the speakers).
- 2. Compile a **list of various topics and guest speakers** to meet the needs of the Membership.
 - Including a focus on young lawyers and students-at-law
 - Including an invitation to the membership to deliver PD presentation
- 3. Submit an **updated PD reporting form** to the Membership for approval at the 2015-16 AGM May 2016).
 - Reporting form will be available on LSN Website for easy access.
- 5. Provide clearer guidance and description on:
 - PD categories
 - Exemption categories including a prorated category for lawyers newly called to the LSN
- 7. Submit a **revised LSN PD policy** to the Membership for approval at the 2015-16 AGM (May 2016).
 - Including new recognized categories and revised self- study hours
- 8. **Notice to Membership re: sanctions** for not fulfilling annual CPD requirements.
- 10. Create **a library of PD materials** accessible to the resident bar and collaborate with the Nunavut Law Foundation for the purchase of materials:
 - Modules, books, DVD's.
 - Portion of the materials to be housed at the Law Society and also available at the local library.
