## **Mandatory and Supplemental Reading Lists**

**Update re: Second Membership Consultation** 

- Further to the June 24, 2021 LSN Annual General Meeting at which time the proposed revised <u>Mandatory</u> and <u>Supplemental</u> Reading Lists were shared with the members, the Executive Committee committed to launching a second round of membership consultation for both reading lists and the proposed Continuing Legal Education (CLE) policy.
- A membership group email inviting members to send their comments on the Reading Lists & the CLE policy was sent on June 29. Two reminders were sent in August.

## Summary of comments received

A member provided the LSN with a suggested list of statutes to add to the Mandatory Reading List, with a focus on statutes that would be more prevalent in a territory rather than in a province:

- Federal Courts Act;
- Territorial Lands Act;
- Nunavut Project Planning and Assessment Act;
- Nunavut Surface Waters & Surface Rights Tribunal Act;
- Access to Information Act.

Another member added the suggestion to include the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement to the Mandatory Reading List.

Another member highlighted the importance of reviewing the statutes that have come into force before we publish the Mandatory Reading List.

Finally, one member shared their support in making the supplemental list mandatory.
