Re: Summary - Request for Proposal Annual Audit Services

In 2020, the Law Society of Nunavut conducted a formal competition for auditors for both itself and the Nunavut Law Foundation.

The Request for Proposals (RFP) was published on the LSN website on 7 February and a notice of that RFP was sent to every Chartered Professional Accountant listed on the website of the Organization of Chartered Professional Accountants of the Northwest Territories and Nunavut (CPA NWT/NU) with "Audit Engagement" status. Price was the single most important scoring component. The term of the contract is three years, plus up to two additional one-year extensions.

The competition closed on 3 April. Four good proposals were received. The evaluation team consisted of Nalini Vaddapalli, Kyle DeYoung and Margaret Hollis (who also provided legal support for the process.) EPR Yellowknife Accounting Professional Corporation was the highest scored. We have agreed on the principal terms of the contract.
