

# **Mandatory Reading List**

To apply for regular membership under the Territorial Mobility Agreement (Permanent Mobility).

All applicants must be familiar with the legislation, Code, Rules and Practice Directives in sections 1 and 2. Applicants must also be familiar with the legislation and Rules in those parts of section 3 that are relevant to their areas of practice. Applicants are responsible for ensuring they are relying upon the most recent rules of court and <u>legislation</u> (not all consolidations of legislation on the Nunavut Legislation website are up to date).

Note: Upon division from the Northwest Territories, Nunavut's first legislation was duplicated, amended or enacted for Nunavut pursuant to the *Nunavut Act* (Canada), s. 29 and 76.05. Nunavut legislation originally enacted for the Northwest Territories retains "N.W.T." in the citation unless officially consolidated (see *Legislation Act*, s. 25(2) and Schedule). Only the Nunavut version of the legislation is referenced here.
