He is a hunter; loves to harvest country food to share with his family and friends, and passing on the traditions to his daughter, with another on the way. Peter has brought his Grade 12 education into continuous skills development programs from Skills Link to the Baffin Fisheries Coalition program, balancing wage economy employment and traditional practices. Peter tries to learn at least one thing per day to better himself, and is currently passionate about helping Inuit struggling with homelessness, addictions and mental health in culturally-safe and trauma-informed services and support.
