The Law Foundation of Nunavut is a non-profit foundation created by the *Legal Profession Act* to manage a fund to support important law-related projects and initiatives in Nunavut. It also provides scholarships & awards to youth and students. The money received by the Foundation come from lawyers practicing in Nunavut, either from the interest earned on monies held in lawyers' trust accounts or from fees from lawyers who don't have trust accounts. The Foundation is governed by a five-member Board of Directors, four of whom are lawyers with one member of the public.
